Background:-

The Bru Sahitya Academy, an NGO for the development of Kau-Bru language has submitted several memorandums to the Government of Tripura for the purpose of recognizing Kau-Bru as a separate minority language in the state of Tripura. In response to their repeated demand, the Government had constituted a committee on the 4th March, 2022. The previous committee in its meeting dated 17/05/2022 had passed a unanimous resolution to re-constitute the committee comprising of members from both Kokborok language community and Kau-Bru language community, along with an academician belonging to non-Kokborok speaking community. Accordingly, the resolution for re-constituting the committee was approved by the government and the new Expert Committee for Kau-Bru language was constituted that came into effect on 30.09.2023.

Introduction:-

At the onset, the Deputy Director, Directorate of Kokborok & Other Minority Languages welcomed all the participants and spelt out the chronology of events that led to the constitution of the Expert Committee for Kau-Bru language. Thereafter the Director, Directorate of Kokborok & Other Minority Languages welcomed Sri Pramod Reang, MLA, and Chairman of the Expert Committee for Kau Bru Language by handing over a flower bouquet. Subsequently, the meeting commenced with active participation from the members of the committee.

Discussion:-

The meeting of the Expert Committee for Kau Bru Language has been convened to discuss the urgent need for obtaining the government's approval for recognizing Kau Bru as a minority language in the state of Tripura. The committee members emphasized the importance of such recognition so that academic & literary activities related to the language can be pursued.

Recognition for Developmental Works: The committee noted that without official recognition by the government, it will be virtually impossible to undertake any literary/academic activities for the Kau-

Bru language. This recognition is not only a matter of identity but also a crucial step towards preserving and promoting the linguistic heritage of the Kau-Bru community.

Historical Neglect: Members expressed concern over the historical neglect of Kau Bru language by the government despite its status as a minority language in Tripura. They highlighted the need for proactive measures to rectify this oversight and ensure that the linguistic rights of the Kau Bru community are upheld.

Resolution taken in the meeting:-

The committee members of the Expert Committee for Kau-Bru language have taken a unanimous decision that the Directorate of Kokborok & OML will initiate a formal proposal for recognizing Kau-Bru as a separate minority language in the state of Tripura.

The meeting ended by extending gratitude to all the participants.
