

**Minute of the meeting of Advisory Committee for Development of Kokborok Language held on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2016 at 11.00 A.M in the Conference Hall of Circuit House, Agartala, under the Chairmanship of Shri Niranjana Debbarma, MLA.**

Shri Niranjana Debbarma, MLA, The Chairman of the Advisory Committee for Development of Kokborok Language initiated the meeting conveying welcome to all members present in the meeting and requested the Director, KBK & OML. The Member Secretary of the Advisory Committee to report on action taken on the decision of the previous meeting.

After the report on actions taken, Members of the Advisory Committee shared their views. All members have emphasised upon the necessity for appointment of Kokborok Graduate and Post Graduate Teachers to ensure the quality teaching of Kokborok Language subject in S/B and secondary Schools.

Members of the Advisory Committee requested the Directorate of KBK & OML to arrange framing R/Rules for appointment of graduate and post graduate teachers for Kokborok with priority to Certificate & Diploma holder in Kokborok from Tripura (Central) University in addition to their general Graduate and Post graduate degree initially.

The Chairman Advisory Committee given instruction to the effect that the total number of Kokborok Teachers may be collected from Education (school) department including list of Senior Basic, High & H/S Schools having 100% Kokborok speaking students for introduction of Kokborok in all of these schools through the initiatives of Kokborok Directorate.

After discussion in details the following decisions have been taken:-

1. Mission Director, RMSA may be requested to provide fund to organise Orientation Training Programme of the teachers teaching Kokborok Language subject at High and H/S Schools and training may be organised at District level.
2. Block level workshop may also be organised to motivate teachers of Kokborok.
3. A reminder may be sent to the Director of a Higher Secondary & Elementary Education to take proper initiatives to prepare the R.R s at the earliest for recruitment of G/T and PGT of Kokborok as there are more than 200 S/B, High and H/S Schools having 100% Kokborok speaking Students.
